1. Sealed quotations are invited for supply and installation of the tissue culture laboratory equipments from the reputed manufacturers / recognized dealers / agents / suppliers for establishing Tissue Culture laboratory on turnkey basis in S. Nijalingappa Sugar Institute, Belgaum.
2. The details of laboratory equipments / instruments / accessories / specifications / requirements and others can be viewed from website – [www.nijalingappasugar.com](http://www.nijalingappasugar.com).
3. Quotationers must furnish their offers the terms of installation for commissioning including training for operating of the equipments and providing the operation and maintenance of the tissue culture laboratory for a period of one year. They have to furnish the documentary proof related to the experience of their similar kind of work.
4. Quotationer shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by any state Government / Government of India / Union Territory.
5. Copies of VAT / CST registration certificate / Service Tax registration and PAN number details are to be enclosed along with the quotation.
6. The last date for submission of the quotation is 19.09.2014 upto 17.30 hrs.
7. Acceptance or rejections of tenders is the discretion of the Institute without assigning any reasons thereof. The eligible bidders will be called for the negotiations if need.

### **Terms and conditions**

#### **1. INVITATION :**

Sealed quotations are invited for supply and installation of the tissue culture laboratory equipments from the reputed manufacturers / recognized dealers / agents / suppliers for establishing Tissue Culture laboratory on turnkey basis in S. Nijalingappa Sugar Institute, Belgaum.

#### **2. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

The list of equipments required is given in Annexure I.

#### **3. SPECIFICATION:**

- a. The details of laboratory equipments / instruments / accessories specification requirements and technical data are provided in Annexure II.
- b. If a particular instrument / equipment including accessories is available both indigenously and also imported than offers may be made for both the instrument / accessories i.e. indigenous and imported separately in Indian currency.
- c. Equipments / instruments with latest technology based on software and / are digital display system and / are with printout devices for test results may be given preference.
- d. Equipments / instruments should be provided with the required calibration certificate wherever applicable.

#### **4. PRICES:**

- a. Prices must be stated for each item separately. The percentage of discount if any on the each item as well as on total price for the entire demand should be quoted if the order to that extent be placed with the quotationer.
- b. Price should be for delivery F.O.R. Belgaum inclusive of charges such as packaging, forwarding and transit insurance, octroi wherever applicable. In case of local deliveries F.O.R. Belgaum prices shall be deemed to include free delivery at S. Nijalingappa Sugar Institute, Belgaum.
- c. Prices quoted must be firm and shall be in Indian currency.

#### **5. DUTIES AND TAXES:**

If it is desired to ask for excise duty or any other charges including Octroi and Sales Tax to be paid extra, the same must be specifically stated with applicant rates and amount. In the absence of any such stipulation in the quotation it will be presumed that, the prices quoted by the quotationer are inclusive of such duties, octroi, taxes and other charges and no liability for such payments will be developed upon purchaser.

**6. DELIVERY PERIOD:**

Delivery period for equipment / instrument / accessories should be within two weeks from the date of placement of order. However preference may be given to the quotationers who could supply the materials immediately or earlier than the due date which shall be specifically mentioned in the quotation / offer.

**7. INSTALLATION, COMMISSIONING AND TRAINING:**

Quotationers must clearly and separately furnish in their offers the terms of installation, commissioning including training / operating the equipments and on application requirements wherever necessary.

**8. GUARANTEE / WARRANTEE :**

The successful quotationers shall furnish the following guarantee / warrantee in case the contract is placed on them.

The equipments offered shall remain in good working condition for a minimum period of 12 months or more from the date of successful commissioning and within this period repair or replacement, if any, shall be provided free of cost. It shall also be guaranteed that, spare parts and accessories will be supplied if and when required by the purchaser after the warrantee period also.

**9. AFTER SALES SERVICE:**

The arrangements and charges for after sales service of the equipments should be clearly mentioned.

**10. TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

For indigenous equipments as well as imported equipments / instruments / items etc. payment to the extent of 95% will be made after delivery and satisfactory installation commissioning and balance 5% on satisfactory performance including training and implementation of application as required.

**11. INCOME TAX CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE:**

Every quotationer shall furnish along with their quotation a photostate copy of their valid / latest income tax clearance certificate. Quotationers are also required to indicate their Permanent Income Tax Account No. (PAN) in their quotation. Offers of quotationers who do not furnish photostate copy of the valid / latest income tax clearance certificate or do not indicate their PAN No. in their quotation are liable to be ignored.

**12. MODE OF SUBMISSION OF QUOTATION:**

- a. The firms should quote on the basis of conditions referred to above, in case any terms and conditions herein are not acceptable to the firm they should specifically state the deviation there from in the body of the quotation.
- b. All quotationers shall be submitted in their letter head / proforma invoice of the firm in English giving clearly the following information.

- i. Sl. No. of the equipment / accessories as mentioned in Annexure I for which the offer is made.
  - ii. The details of the equipments / accessories offered with its specifications.
  - iii. Rate per unit
  - iv. Delivery period
  - v. Photo copy of the latest income tax clearance certificate.
  - vi. Other details / documents as mentioned elsewhere in the terms and conditions.
- c. Individual signing the quotations and connected documents must specify the capacity in which they sign (e.g.)
- i. Whether signing as “Sole Proprietor” of the firm or as attorney.
  - ii. Whether signing as “Partner of the firm” or as attorney.
  - iii. Whether for the firm as “Agent”
- d. Quotations received after the last date may not be considered. It will therefore be in the interest of the quotationers to ensure that, the quotations are submitted well in time.
- e. The quotation shall be enclosed in Sealed Envelop duly subscribed “Quotation for Laboratory Equipments for Tissue Culture Lab” and it should be addressed to the Director, S. Nijalingappa Sugar Institute, Belgaum. On the Sealed Envelop the quotationer shall mention his/her name, phone / cell number for contact.

### **13. RIGHT OF ACCEPTANCE OF OFFER:**

Incomplete offers specially with regard to not detailing the specifications of the equipments are liable to be rejected. The purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject lowest or any offer in whole or in part without assigning any reasons. It would therefore be in the interest of the quotationers to clarify, understand that the purchaser may accept offers for any part of the configuration offered to his choice and the quotationers shall supply the same at the rate quoted.

### **14. JURISDICTION:**

All questions, disputes of differences arising out of contract, if concluded shall be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of Hon'ble Court of justice at Belgaum.
